Launched in 1948 in Hobart, Tasmania for prominent Australian offshore sailor John Colquhoun. She is constructed from Huon Pine and proved herself as a capable, ocean going yacht. Colquhoun raced 'Lass-o-Luss' in five Sydney to Hobart races between 1949 and 1960, before selling her to ocean racing legend Bill Psaltis in 1961.

Psaltis shipped the boat to Greece for a cruising holiday (1964-1965) then returned her to Sydney where he sailed her consistently out of the Cruising Yacht Club of Australia.

Her current owners have loving kept 'Lass-O-Luss' in good working order and enjoyed cruising her on Sydney's idyllic waterway- Pittwater!

The topsides and hull below water line have been stripped, sheathed and re-painted. She is fitted with a 30 hp Yanmar engine which has been serviced regularly.

'Lass O Luss' has a lot of history and is a superb, classic sailing yacht.
