Deck Hardware / Fittings	Deck Description	The large open cockpit is unique on a boat of this size. It is self-draining and has all weather protection. There are 4 x deck style chairs and a folding table. Timber decks sanded and oiled and ceiling recently painted, with new cockpit lights recently installed.
	Ground Tackle /Anchor Winch	There is a CQR anchor, and anchor winch and 10 odd metres of chain and ample warp.
	Covers	The secret of owning and maintaining a good timber boat is an excellent set of covers which are easy to fit and remove and easy to store. All covers were renewed in 2017. The covers around the cockpit all roll up, and the foredeck is also completely covered when not in use.
Accommodation	Accommodation Description	2 x full single berths. Cabin ceiling has been recently painted. Stepping into the cabin there is full headroom.
	Toilet	There is a private toilet area located fwd. with a new electric toilet and holding tank

Galley	Galley Description	The galley area is a sink with access for hot and cold water and small bench and cupboards underneath. There are ample plates and basic utensils. There is a stainless-steel BBQ stored below which has fittings for the stern.
Safety Equipment	Safety Gear	Flares, jackets. All safety gear is to be audited at time of survey. New bilge pumps " Manual & Electric.
Electrics / Electronics	Electrics	Electrics: New radio, stereo and speakers. VHF and 27 meg radios, outlets for power. There are two batteries which can be isolated, charged via a solar panel fitted on the cabin top. Navigation and interior lights, new cockpit lights. Electronics / Navigation: There is a GPS plotter with depth sounder/fish finder.
