The teak cockpit is in good condition and offers a fantastic space for entertaining or relaxing while cruising, with comfortable seating on both port and starboard sides. Engine access is

A stainless-steel frame with a full awning provides excellent protection and shade over the entire cockpit area. Access to the forward deck is easy via steps on both the port and starboard sides, with wide, comfortable walkaround access leading to the bow area.
